- **Each Sunday** simply contains a verse of encouragement.
- **Each Monday** is a day of REPENTANCE. The prayer points focus on humbling ourselves before a Holy God, repenting, and turning from our wicked ways.
- **Each Tuesday through Friday**, has specific prayer focuses with 3-4 prayer points.
- **Each Saturday** is a day of thanksgiving with a few verses to remind us to have an attitude of thankfulness.

WEEK 1: June 1 – 7

Sunday Encouragement June 1

"Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you" (Exodus 20:12). "Forsake not our mother's teaching" (Proverbs 1:8b).

Monday Repentance June 2

PRAISE:

"O Lord, You are my God. I will exalt You, I will praise Your name, For You have done wonderful things; Your counsels of old are faithfulness and truth" (Isaiah 25:1). I trust You in all things, Father.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. I repent, for I "have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts, and from thy judgments" (Daniel 9:5).
- 2. For You, God, have "not called us for impurity, but in holiness" (1 Thess. 4:7). I am to be set apart and blameless for Your Kingdom. I repent and ask for You to cleanse me so I can ascend the hill of the Lord and stand in Your holy place with clean hands and a pure heart (Psalm 24:4).
- 3. Father, I acknowledge that sin pulls everything out of alignment. "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts. See if there is any wicked way in me and lead me in the way everlasting" (Psalm 139:24).

Tuesday Women of Courage June 3

PRAISE:

"For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has mercy on you" (Isa. 54:10). Thank you for Your covenant with Israel and for Your peace over Israel.

PRAYER POINTS:

1. **PRAY** for women to live godly lives, setting an example for their children, friends and all those they encounter. **PRAY** that mothers will "Train up their children in

- the way they should go, and when they are old they will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6). We thank You, Father for examples in scripture of women who loved and honored You.
- 2. **PRAY** the Lord gives women in the Church, courage like Rahab when she hid the spies, thinking not of her own life (Joshua 6:25). **PRAY** that women's lives exemplify faith like Rahab; being mentioned in the Hall of Faith in Hebrews 11.
- 3. **PRAY** women will have the courage and faith of Esther, who saved her people from destruction by prayer and fasting (Esther 4:14-16). **PRAY** women learn to wait on the Lord and not rush to action.

Wednesday Women as Faithful Followers June 4

PRAISE:

"Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord!" (Psalm 150:6). I lift up my voice and I praise Your holy name.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** that mothers who do not know you will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. For if they "confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ, and believe in their your heart that God raised Hin from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9-10). "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life" (Romans 6:23).
- 2. **PRAY** women become faithful followers of Jesus as was Mary Magdalene, who was spoken of in all four of the gospels (Matthew 27 & 28, John 19 & 20, Luke 8 & 24, Mark 15 & 16).
- 3. **PRAY** women anoint You with the precious ointment of their lives as did Mary of Bethany when she poured costly oil on Jesus head and washed His feet with her hair (Matthew 26:6-13; Mark 14:3; John 12:3).
- 4. **PRAY** mothers dedicate their children to the Lord as did Hannah (1 Samuel 1). **PRAY** mothers give their children unto the Lord and trust Him with them, when they are young and when they are adults.

Thursday Women Fulfilling Their Roles June 5

PRAISE:

"The Lord is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation" (Psalm 118:14).

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** that women in the Church step into the identity for which they are created, in God's image with inherent dignity and value. Women are created from the side of man; a beautiful picture of partnership (Genesis 2:21-23). "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them" (Genesis 1:27).
- 2. **PRAY** that women fulfil the role You have for us as described in Titus 2: "But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine. Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled" (vs. 3-5).
- 3. **PRAY** that those who are married, will fulfil the role of wives to set an example for our daughters and other young women. "Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. Let the wife see that she respects her husband" (Ephesians 5:22).

Friday Women Who Are Fruitful June 6

PRAISE:

"The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; therefore, my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I will praise Him" (Psalm 28:7). I lift up my voice in song to praise Your name, the name above all other names.

- PRAY that women see the importance of their role as mother. Leah and Rachel's sons became the 12 tribes of Israel (Genesis 30). Ruth bore Obed, the father of Jesse, the father of David, who would be king, in the lineage of Jesus (Ruth 4:13-17). Elizabeth bore John the Baptist who would be the forerunner for Jesus (Luke 1). Mary found favor in the site of the Lord and bore Jesus, our Savior.
- 2. **PRAY** that women see their importance in our nation's future. Deborah, a prophetess and judge, led Israel to military victory and provided guidance to the nation. "The highways were deserted, and the travelers walked along the byways. Village life ceased, until <u>I, Deborah, arose, a mother</u> in Israel" (Judges 5:6-7).
- 3. **PRAY** that women see the importance their role in the body of Christ, that "her worth is far above rubies. Strength and honor are her clothing; she shall rejoice in

time to come. She opens her mouth with wisdom, and on her tongue is the law of kindness" (Proverbs 31: 1, 25-26).

Saturday Day of Thanksgiving June 7

"My lips shall utter praise, for You teach me Your statutes. My tongue shall speak of Your word, for all Your commandments are righteousness. Let Your hand become my help, for I have chosen Your precepts. I long for Your salvation, O Lord, and Your law is my delight. Let my soul live, and it shall praise You; let Your judgments help me" (Psalm 119:171-175).

WEEK 2: June 8 - 14

Sunday Encouragement June 8

"I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works" (Psalm 9:1). I praise You, Father, for how You protect America and all that concerns us.

Monday Repentance June 9

PRAISE:

"I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness" (Isaiah 61:10). I praise You and rejoice that Your blood has covered my sin.

- 1. Forgive us Lord, "for provoking our children to wrath, for not bringing them up in the fear and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4), and for not "training up our children in the way that they should go" (Proverbs 22:6), for we have neglected the teaching and commands of the Lord, and the fear of the Lord is not in them.
- 2. I repent, for I have not "kept the commandments of the LORD, my God", I have not "walked in Your ways," nor have I "loved You and served You, the Lord my God, with all of my heart and with all of my soul," and I have not feared You as You desire (Deuteronomy 8:6 and 10:12).
- 3. "The fear of the Lord is to hate evil: pride and arrogance, and the evil way, and the perverse mouth I hate" (Proverbs 8:13). I repent for not hating every evil work and for stepping into the trap of the enemy called "tolerance." I have been arrogant in

my worldview and have at times come into agreement with the "PRIDE" movement, which exalts independence from God, boasts in sin, self and selfish, lustful desires.

Tuesday

Original Intent for Fathers

June 10

PRAISE:

"Every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!" (Rev. 5:13).

"The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard. Their sound has gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world" (Psalm 19:1-4).

- 1. **PRAY** that fathers who do not know you will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. For if they "confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ, and believe in your heart that God raised Hin from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9-10). "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life" (Romans 6:23).
- 2. **PRAY** the men in (STATE) are blameless, faithful to their wives, temperate, soberminded, of good behavior, are hospitable and eager to share the gospel, not given to much wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but are gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous, and will lead their homes in righteousness (1 Timothy 3).
- 3. **PRAY** the God will "turn the hearts of fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to their fathers" (Malachi 4:6) in love, discipline, wisdom and compassion. **PRAY** men will lead their children to become men and women who honor others, follow Jesus faithfully, and are led by the Holy Spirit building a legacy of generations of faithful followers of Christ.
- 4. **PRAY** for a return to God's design of man and woman, becoming one flesh, just as in creation. Eve was bone of Adam: bone of his bone and flesh of his flesh (Gen 2:23-24). Marriage was established in the garden of Eden between one man and one woman. **PRAY** for a return to covenant marriage and the original intent of God's plan for the home according to Ephesians 5:22-28.

Wednesday

Fathers Rise Up

June 11

PRAISE:

"Make a joyful shout to God, all the earth! Sing out the honor of His name; make His praise glorious. Say to God, "How awesome are Your works! Through the greatness of Your power Your enemies shall submit themselves to You. All the earth shall worship You and sing praises to You; They shall sing praises to Your name." Selah (Psalm 66: 1-4).

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** fathers will rise up and understand that their position is to be models of honor, bravery, steadfastness and righteousness to their children. We call forth fathers to now take their positions for the children of (state); even the fatherless. For "children are a crown" to their fathers (Proverbs 17:6).
- 2. **PRAY** the hearts of fathers in (STATE) turn to their children in love, discipline, wisdom and compassion (Malachi 4:6). **PRAY** men will lead their children to become men and women who honor others, follow after Jesus faithfully, and are led by the Holy Spirit to establish the Kingdom of God on the earth, building a legacy of generations of faithful followers of Christ.
- 3. **PRAY** the Fathers will long and thirst after God and will rise up early each day to seek Him (Psalm 63:1), interceding for His people, their families, the government, and the land. **PRAY** God's men are "strong and of good courage" (Joshua 1:9) for the Lord their God is with them wherever they go.

Thursday

Fathers Fear of the Lord

June 12

PRAISE:

"And in that day you will say: "Praise the Lord, call upon His name; declare His deeds among the peoples, make mention that His name is exalted" (Isaiah 12:4). I praise You, Father, for men and fathers who stand up and exalt Your name.

- 1. **PRAY** that fathers walk in covenant from generation to generation. "The LORD our God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments" (Deuteronomy 7:9). For His "mercy is for those who fear God from generation to generation" (Luke 1:50).
- 1. **PRAY** that fathers walk in the fear of the Lord. "Whoever fears the Lord has a secure fortress, and for their children it will be a refuge" (Prov. 14:26). The "fear of the Lord is a fountain of life" for the family (Prov. 14:27). For "In the fear of the Lord

- there is strong confidence" (Prov. 14:26) and His "steadfast love endures forever, and Your faithfulness to all generations" (Psalm 100:5).
- 2. **PRAY** that fathers will give testimony to the young of God's strength and wonderful works. "One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts" (Psalm 145:4). "That the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, that they may arise and declare them to their children, that they may set their hope in God" (Psalm 78:6-7).

Friday Fathers Give Instruction June 13

PRAISE:

"The entrance of Your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple" (Psalm 119:130). We praise You, Father for Your Word that brings light to all who will receive it, and Your Word will build strong families.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** that fathers give wise instructions and "speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine" (Titus 2:1). "Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart" (Proverbs 29:17).
- 2. **PRAY** that children and youth's hearts are open to the instruction of their fathers. "Hear, my son, your father's instruction" (Proverbs 1:8a), "hear instruction and be wise" (Proverbs 8:33) "...that you may be wise in your latter days" (Proverbs 19:20b). For "A wise son makes a glad father" (Proverbs 15:20a). For when they heed the way of wisdom, the right paths are shown to the children so that their "... steps will not be hindered, and when they run, they will not stumble" (Proverbs 4: 11-12). For as it is written, "Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations. Ask your father, and he will show you; your elders, and they will tell you" (Deuteronomy 32:7).
- 3. **PRAY** that fathers teach and model humility before their families. "Likewise, you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble" (Luke 14:11).

Saturday Day of Thanksgiving June 14

"The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; therefore, my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I will praise Him" (Psalm 28:7). Thank you, Father, for being my strength and my shield!

WEEK 3: June 15 - 21

Sunday

Father's Day

June 15

"Cast your burden on the LORD, and He will sustain you; He will never permit the righteous to be moved" (Psalm 55:2).

Monday

Repentance

June 16

PRAISE:

"I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1). "Let my mouth be filled with Your praise and with Your glory all the day" (Psalm 71:8). Father, I thank You for those in education who lift up Your name.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. Abba Father, I repent that I have become complacent and apathetic about the nature of who You are. I confess I have been wise in my own eyes and have not feared You, nor departed from evil (Prov. 3:7).
- 2. I repent for not trusting in You wholeheartedly and instead trusting in myself, my own understanding, knowledge, and talent, my own power, platform, and wealth, political figures, ungodly alliances, and the strength of my nation's army. I have put my trust in people, as in the days of the Judges, and I have done what is right in my own eyes (Judges 21:25). Forgive me.
- 3. I repent for failing to uphold the covenants the generations before made with You, Lord. I repent for "not driving out the evil in our land," which has now become "pricks in our eyes and thorns in our sides and harasses us in the land where we dwell" (Numbers 33:55).

Tuesday

Protection Over Children

June 17

PRAISE:

"I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I learn Your righteous judgments" (Psalm 119:7). Father, I praise You that You are righteous and that even in judgment, I can praise Your name and experience Your love.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. PRAY for God's protection and mercy over our children's souls and ask for divine appointments that they will encounter the One True God. PRAY parents will show by example, a belief in the Lord Jesus and in agreement with His Word. PRAY according to Acts 16:31, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."
- 2. **PRAY** protection over the unborn. "Open your mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy" (Proverbs 31:9). **ASK** the Lord to intervene in our state and nation, to stop the shedding of innocent blood.
- 3. **PRAY** for protection and mercy over our prodigals until they return home. "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it" (Luke 15:4). **PRAY** the Father draws the prodigals unto Himself (John 6:44). And "...when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion" (Luke 15:20). As it is written, His "mercy endures forever" (Psalm 136).

Wednesday Children Walking in Truth June 18

PRAISE:

"But the humble will inherit the land and will delight themselves in abundant prosperity" (Psalm 37:11). Father, I bless Your name and ask for a humble heart before You so that You may protect and bless America.

- 1. **PRAY** that our children seek truth, in the fear of the Lord, and are not deceived by the enemy's schemes. For "the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding" (Proverbs 9:10). **PRAY** that once our children see truth, they walk in it.
- 2. **PRAY** for all confusion around sex, which the enemy calls "gender", to be removed from the minds of our children. **PRAY** that blind eyes are opened, and the veil is removed, to see male and female as God created them (2 Kings 6:17). God, you created male and female (Genesis 2). You, Father, have declared the intention for our children. "All your sons will be taught of the Lord; and the well-being of your sons will be great" (Isaiah 54:13).
- 3. **PRAY** for those who speak confusion over our children, to come out of darkness into the light. **ASK** the Lord to encounter them with His presence. According to Isaiah 42:22, these people are "robbed and spoiled; they are snared in holes and in prison houses. They are prey and no one delivers", but I cry out for them to be

restored. Bring the blind by a way they do not know and lead them in paths of righteousness. Make darkness light before them!

Thursday Godly Education for Our Children June 19

"A thorough knowledge of the Bible is worth more than a college education."

~ Theodore Roosevelt

PRAISE:

"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable" (Psalm 145:3).

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge" (Proverbs 1:7). Because knowledge belongs to the Lord, we **PRAY** that all educational institutions in (state) will hear the good news of the gospel, create peaceful and righteous environments for our children, and proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord in our schools. As it is written in Isaiah 52:7, "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who bring good news, who proclaims peace, who brings glad tidings of good things, who proclaims salvation, who says to Zion, your God reigns!"
- 2. **PRAY** that parents take the responsibility of educating our children in the precepts of God's Word as a foundation for education. "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up" (Deuteronomy 6:6-7).
- 3. **PRAY** parents will stand strong and protect their children by strongly protest schools using ungodly curriculum, providing obscene books, adopting demonically inspired sexual preference and transgender policies, and promoting an anti-God worldview. We **PRAY** that schools for all ages teach "...whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and there is anything praiseworthy meditate on these things" (Philippians 4:8).

Friday Children: A Heritage From The Lord June 20

PRAISE:

"I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works" (Psalm 9:1).

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** that mothers who do not know you will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. For if they "confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9-10). "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life" (Romans 6:23).
- 2. **PRAY** that parents remember that our children and youth belong to God first, and the parents second. "Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one's youth" (Psalm 127:3-4).
- 3. **PRAY** that parents bless their children and speak life over them. Jesus Himself, "took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them" (Mark 10:16). **PRAY** that our "descendants will be mighty on earth; the generation of the upright will be blessed" Psalm 112:2).
- 4. **PRAY** for learning to walk righteously, honoring those who walked before them. "Grandchildren are the crown of old men, and the glory of sons is their fathers" (Proverbs 17:6). "All your children shall be taught by the LORD, and great shall be the peace of your children" (Isaiah 54:13).

Saturday Day of Thanksgiving June 21

"But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me" (2 Corinthians 12:9).

WEEK 4: June 22 - 30

Sunday Encouragement June 22

Monday Repentance June 23

PRAISE:

"I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I learn Your righteous judgments" (Psalm 119:7). Father, I praise You that You are righteous and that even in judgment, I can praise Your name and experience Your love.

[&]quot;Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might" (Ephesians 6:10).

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We repent for the times we have not shown honor to all generations. We repent for the comments spoken out about the mature generation's ideals or actions and for the attitudes we have held about the younger generation. We acknowledge there is a disconnect between generations. We repent for lack of respect and pray for a returning to the instruction of Leviticus 19:32 for honor to be shown to the Elderly in the fear of the LORD.
- 2. Place my sin of passive acceptance under the blood of Your Son, Yeshua. From this point forward, I will "Abhor what is evil and cling to what is good. Being kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love" (Romans 12:9). I will stand up for what is righteous, I will "open my mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy" (Proverbs 31:9).
- 3. Forgive me when I have not cared for others who treat me poorly. As it is written, "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in doing so you will heap coals of fire on his head." Then I will "not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Romans 12:20).

Tuesday Families Return to Covenant June 24

PRAISE:

"... whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy, meditate on these things" (Phil. 4:8). I praise Your name for those who speak truth and righteousness in our media.

- 1. **PRAY** for a return to covenant marriage (Genesis 2:24) and for the original intent of God's plan for the home according to Ephesians 5:22-28:
 - "Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, His Body, of which He is the Savior. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the Word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So, husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself.
- 2. **PRAY** for families to follow the commandments of the Lord. "And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. And the second, like it,

- is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these" (Mark 12: 30-31). **PRAY** that families "with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:2-3).
- 3. **PRAY** families walk in the New Covenant. "And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance" (Hebrews 9:15). **PRAY** that families fulfill the great commission in their neighborhoods and ""Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15).

Wednesday Families Return to Fear of the Lord June 25

PRAISE:

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ" (Eph. 1:3).

- 1. **PRAY** for the fear of the Lord to return to the family. **PRAY** for humility to be an earmark of the family structure in America. "The fear of the Lord is the instruction for wisdom, and before honor comes humility" (Proverbs 15:33). **PRAY** that parents teach and model the fear of the Lord before their children. For as it is written, "In the fear of the Lord there is strong confidence, and his children will have refuge" (Proverbs 14:26).
- 2. **PRAY** for peace, rest and protection to come to families who fear the Lord. For as it is written, "The fear of the Lord leads to life, so that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by evil" (Proverbs 19:23).
- 3. **PRAY** for the fear of the Lord to grip parents in such a way that they see the eternal before the temporal. **PRAY** that parents would prioritize church or other godly activities over sports, dance or any other activity that takes away from the focusing the children on the eternal hope in Christ.
- 4. **PRAY** that parents will balance teaching the children about unity in the Body of Christ with teamwork in a secular environment. **PRAY** parents teach their children a love for the lost without an "acceptance" or "tolerance" of sin.

Thursday Honor & Protection Over Elderly June 26

PRAISE:

"Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, Praise the name of the Lord" (Psalm 113:1). I will bless Your name for You are worthy of my praise.

PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. **PRAY** that those who have walked before us are fruitful until the time they are called into God's presence. "They shall still bear fruit in old age; they shall be fresh and flourishing" (Psalm 92:14).
- 2. **PRAY** for length of life and health in the latter years, for as it is written, "For length of days and long life and peace they will add to you" (Proverbs 3:2).
- 3. **PRAY** that the Body of Christ honor those who have laid a foundation for us. "The silver-haired head is a crown of glory, if it is found in the way of righteousness" (Proverbs 16:31).

Philippians 2:15 proclaims that "they will become blameless and harmless, Children of God without fault, in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among who they shine as lights in the world" and they "shall possess the gates of their enemies" (Gen 22:17). "A righteous man who walks in his integrity; how blessed are his sons after him" (Proverbs 20:7).

3. **PRAY** that families set up an altar of prayer in their homes and that they desire to walk in righteousness. "Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (James 5:16). "As is Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness" (Psalm 48:10).
