## FAITH & FAMILY MONTH

Thanks to Dr. Keena Cowser with **PrayerLink.us** for her prayerful work of putting this prayer guide together. We pray that thousands of lives will be impacted as we pray for families.

Commenting on the first century church story in Acts 4:31, Leonard Ravenhill states the contrast of the first century church to the present-day church in his book, Why Revival Tarrys. He shares, “Our accent is on paying, theirs was on praying. When we have paid, the place is taken; when they had prayed, the place was shaken.” He also writes, “The Church has advisors by the carload. but where are her agonizers?” Lastly, “What has hell to fear other than a God-anointed, prayer-powered church?” (Why Revival Tarrys, Leonard Ravenhill, pgs. 25, 138, 139)

**The answer to why revival tarrys is simple: We, the Church, are willing to live without it.** As quoted, we are willing to pay but not to pray. This prayer guide is intended for the Church to see our communities taken and shaken. Luke, the writer of Acts, gives us another principle why the prayer of the first church was so powerful in Acts 4:32 where “All the believers were one in heart and mind...”

Yes, they prayed but it was **unified prayer**. This is the power of this prayer guide where we can pray individually as well as corporately as the New Testament Church as “one in heart and mind.” We all can pray as **ONE** for the Biblical family to be defended and developed through the month of June.

The enemy has come in like a flood, and the Spirit of the Lord needs to raise a standard against him (Isaiah 59:19). This prayer guide is part of that standard. We can also raise the standard against the enemy who has brought an attack against family, marriage, and God’s design for male and female genders. If nothing else happens but unified, desperate specific prayer for families in our communities, then we are successful. Jim Cymbala shares, “If we are courageous enough to go on the spiritual attack to be mighty men and women of prayer and faith, there is no limit to what God can accomplish through us” (Fresh Wind, Fresh Fire, pg. 181). - ❖ **Each Monday** is a day of REPENTANCE. The prayer points focus on humbling ourselves before a Holy God, repenting, and turning from our sin.
- ❖ **Each Tuesday through Friday**, has specific prayer focuses with 3-4 prayer points.
- ❖ **Each Saturday** is a day of thanksgiving with a few verses to remind us to have an attitude of thankfulness.
- ❖ **Each Sunday** simply contains a verse of encouragement.

## WEEK 1: June 1 – 7

Monday

Repentance

June 1

**PRAISE:**

*“Oh, give thanks to the Lord! Call upon His name; make known His deeds among the peoples! Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; talk of all His wondrous works! Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the Lord!”* (Psalm 105:1-3). Praise Him until your heart finds that place of rejoicing.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. Father, I repent for not looking to Your WORD for direction, comfort and instruction in our lives. For You have told us *“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye”* (Psalm 32:8). *“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path”* (Psalm 119:105).
2. Forgive me for the casual and lackadaisical approach I take to your WORD. Help me to understand that You, *“magnifies Your WORD above Your name”* (Psalm 138:2) for *“the WORD of the Lord endures forever”* (1 Peter 1:25).
3. I repent for not obeying the WORD of God. *“Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves”* (James 1:22). *“For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope”* (Romans 15:4).

Tuesday

Foundation in the Word

June 2

**PRAISE:**

*“Stand by the ways and see and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; and you will find rest for your souls”* (Jeremiah 6:16). Praise Him for the foundations laid in generations past.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** for families to spend time centered around His WORD so that we can walk in righteousness as a family and center our lives around Jesus. The WORD is truth and we are sanctified by it (John 17:17) and it sets us free (John 8:32). For *“In the beginning was the WORD, and the WORD was with God, and the WORD was God”* (John 1:1).

2. **PRAY** for our nation to establish His WORD as a corner stone of our government so that we may walk in light and not darkness. *“The entrance of His WORD brings light and understanding”* (Psalm 119:130).
3. **PRAY** that faith in God grows in our families. *“Faith comes by hearing and hearing through the WORD of Christ”* (Romans 10:17). **PRAY** our hearts are good ground so the seed of the WORD will grow and yield fruit (Luke 8:8-11) and **ask** the Father for the WORD of God to continue to increase in the lives of our families as it did in Acts 6:7. For *“His WORD does not return void”* (Isaiah 55:11) as God watches over His WORD to perform it (Jeremiah 1:12).

**Wednesday**

**Fathers Be Steadfast**

**June 3**

**PRAISE:**

*“The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge; my Savior, You save me from violence”* (2 Samuel 22:3). I praise You, Father, with my voice and with my life, for being all I need in any situation.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** the fathers will long and thirst after God and will rise up early each day to seek Him (Psalm 63:1), interceding for their families and our nation’s leaders. **PRAY** God’s men are *“strong and of good courage”* (Joshua 1:9) for the Lord their God is with them wherever they go.
2. **PRAY** fathers will understand that their position is to be models of honor, bravery, steadfastness and righteousness to their children. We call forth men to be steadfast in love and protection over all the children in (state). For *“children are a crown”* to their fathers (Proverbs 17:6).
3. **PRAY** the hearts of fathers in (STATE) turn to their children in love, discipline, wisdom and compassion (Malachi 4:6). **PRAY** fathers will lead their children to become men and women who honor others and follow after Jesus faithfully, to establish the Kingdom of God on the earth.

**Thursday**

**Women in Covenantal Role**

**June 4**

**PRAISE:**

*“Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place”* (2 Corinthians 2:14). Thank Him for allowing you to be a vessel He uses to show the love of Christ to those in your life.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** for a return of the hearts of women to the most important role of wife and mother in a covenantal marriage (Genesis 2:24) and for the original intent of God’s plan for the home (Eph. 5:22-28, Col. 3:18, Prov. 31:10-31).
2. **PRAY** for mothers to remember that her children belong to God first and to bless His name for the children entrusted to her. *“Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one’s youth”* (Psalm 127:3-4).
3. **PRAY** that mothers who do not know you will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ so they may raise their children in the love and admonition of the Lord, alongside their husbands (Eph. 6:4). For if they *“confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ, and believe in their heart that God raised Him from the dead, they will be saved”* (Romans 10:9-10).

**Friday                      Protection Over Children/Youth                      June 5**

**PRAISE:**

*“But He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me”* (2 Corinthians 12:9). Praise the Lord for His sufficient grace in your life.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** for protection and mercy over our prodigals until they return home. *“What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it”* (Luke 15:4). **PRAY** the Father draws the prodigals unto Himself (John 6:44). And *“...when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion”* (Luke 15:20). As it is written, His *“mercy endures forever”* (Psalm 136).
2. **PRAY** and **ASK** that any of our children who do not know Jesus/Yeshua as Lord and savior, will encounter the One True God and that His mercy will be extended to them. **PRAY** for God’s protection over their souls until such a time. **PRAY** parents will show by example, a belief in the Lord Jesus and the power of His Word. **PRAY** according to Acts 16:31, *“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.”*
3. **PRAY** protection over the unborn. *“Open your mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy”* (Proverbs 31:9). **ASK** the Lord to intervene in our state and nation, to stop the shedding of innocent blood.

**Saturday Day of Thanksgiving June 6**

*“He stores up sound wisdom for the righteous: He is a shield to them that walk uprightly”* (Proverbs 2:7). I praise You, Father, for the wisdom You give us for the task ahead and for Your shield that protects us on this path.

**Sunday Encouragement June 7**

*“Every word of God proves true; He is a shield to those who take refuge in Him”* (Proverbs 30:5).

**WEEK 2: June 8 - 14**

**Monday Repentance June 8**

**PRAISE:**

*“For Your righteousness, O God, reaches to the heavens, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You?”* (Psalm 71:19).

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. Forgive me for taking my eyes off of You and Your commandments. I have placed my own needs and wants ahead of others and ahead of your will and have made myself an idol (1 Timothy 6:10).
2. I repent, for I have not *“kept the commandments of the LORD, my God”*, I have not *“walked in Your ways,”* nor have I *“loved You and served You, the Lord my God, with all of my heart and with all of my soul,”* and I have not feared You as You desire (Deuteronomy 8:6 and 10:12).
3. Abba Father, I repent that I have become complacent and apathetic about the nature of who You are. I confess I have been wise in my own eyes and have not feared You, nor departed from evil (Proverbs 3:7).

**Tuesday Foundation in the Son June 9**

**PRAISE:**

*“Praise the Lord! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever”* (Psalm 106:1). Thank the Lord for the specific times He was merciful to you.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that families lay a solid foundation on Yeshua as foretold in the Old Testament. *“Behold, I am the one who has laid as a foundation in Zion, a stone, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, of a sure foundation: ‘Whoever believes will not be in haste’ (Isaiah 28:16). ‘For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ’ (1 Corinthians 3:11).*
2. **PRAY** the love of the Son be exhibited through families in our nation. **PRAY** we learn how to show love, kindness and mercy to one another as Christ showed to us. *“When the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy” (Titus 3:4-5). “Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you” (Ephesians 4:32).*
3. **PRAY** that families look for the coming of the Lord and live in a way that gives glory and honor to Him until He comes. *“And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work” (Revelation 22:12). “We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed” (1 Corinthians 15:51-52). “For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus, we shall always be with the Lord” (1 Thes. 4:16-17).*

**Wednesday****Fathers in Covenantal Role****June 10****PRAISE:**

*“Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His Name; bring an offering, and come before Him; worship the Lord in holy array” (1 Chron. 16:29).* We give You, Lord, glory above all other names and above kings, rulers and presidents.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** the men in (STATE) are blameless, faithful to their wives, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, are hospitable and eager to share the gospel, not given to much wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but are gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous, and will lead their homes in righteousness (1 Timothy 3).
2. **PRAY** for a return to God’s design of man and woman; becoming one flesh, just as in creation. Eve was bone of Adam: bone of his bone and flesh of his flesh (Gen 2:23-24). Marriage was established in the garden of Eden between one man and

one woman. **PRAY** for a return to covenant marriage and the original intent of God's plan for the home (Eph. 5:22-28, Col. 3:21).

3. **PRAY** that fathers walk in the fear of the Lord. *"Whoever fears the Lord has a secure fortress, and for their children it will be a refuge"* (Prov. 14:26). The *"fear of the Lord is a fountain of life"* for the family (Prov. 14:27). For *"In the fear of the Lord there is strong confidence"* (Prov. 14:26) and His *"steadfast love endures forever, and His faithfulness to all generations"* (Psalm 100:5).

Thursday

Women's Identity in Christ

June 11

**PRAISE:**

*"Those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint"* (Isaiah 40:31). Praise Him for the strength He gives you to run the race.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that women in the Church step into the identity for which they are created, in God's image with inherent dignity and value. Women are created from the side of man; a beautiful picture of partnership (Genesis 2:21-23). *"So God created man in His own image; in the image of God, He created him; male and female He created them"* (Genesis 1:27).
2. **PRAY** that older women teach the younger women as described in Titus 2: *"But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine. Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled"* (vs. 3-5).
3. **PRAY** for women to live a life that reflects God's nature by living godly; setting an example for their children, friends and all those they encounter. **PRAY** mothers will *"Train up their children in the way they should go, and when they are old they will not depart from it"* (Proverbs 22:6).

Friday

Families Walk in Righteousness

June 12

**PRAISE:**

*"Behold, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert"* (Isaiah 43:19). Thank You, LORD for what You are doing in my family.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** the fear of the Lord brings righteousness to families. *“Is not your fear of God your confidence, and the integrity of your ways your hope?”* (Job 4:6). *“The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the judgments of the Lord are true; they are righteous altogether”* (Psalm 19:9).
2. **PRAY** that families set up an altar of prayer in their homes and that they desire to walk in righteousness. *“Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much”* (James 5:16). *“As is Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness”* (Psalm 48:10).
3. Pray that children honor their parents as unto the Lord so they may live long, please the Lord and walk in honor and righteousness (Exodus 20:12, Eph. 6:1-3, Col. 3:20, Deut. 5:16).

**Saturday Day of Thanksgiving June 13**

*“O Lord, You are my God. I will exalt You, I will praise Your name, For You have done wonderful things; Your counsels of old are faithfulness and truth”* (Isaiah 25:1). I trust You in all things, Father.

**Sunday Encouragement June 14**

*“But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you”* (1 Peter 5:10).

**WEEK 3: June 15 - 21**

**Monday Repentance June 15**

**PRAISE:**

*“Unto Thee, O my strength, will I sing; for my God is our defense and the God of our MERCY.” We will sing of Thy power; yea, we will sing aloud of Thy MERCY in the morning; for You are our defense and refuge in the day of trouble”* (Psalm 59: 16-17).

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. I repent for having tolerated evil words and deeds that have been projected towards Your people, Israel, and for not anguishing in prayer over the veil that they still wear. Forgive me that I have not lamented over Your people as You do, deeply desiring to gather them unto Yourself and into Your Kingdom (Matthew 23:37).
2. Forgive me for not quickly offering mercy to others and as You have forgiven me (Ephesians 4:32). Help me to pray without ceasing to stay in intimate contact with You (1 Thess. 5:16-18).
3. Forgive me for my lack of faith and trust, for Your arm has not been shortened and Your Word is true (Numbers 11:23). Help me to trust in Your Word and to come boldly to Your throne on behalf of Israel, of my nation, and my family. *“Therefore, let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need”* (Hebrews 4:16).

**Tuesday**

**Foundation in Prayer**

**June 16**

**PRAISE:**

*“Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise You. Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name”* (Psalm 63:3-4). I praise You, Lord and lift up my hands toward heaven to acknowledge Your lovingkindness over Your Church, both Jew and Gentile.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that our families pray together to keep the enemy from pulling them into temptation or sin. *“Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak”* (Matthew 26:41). *“Seek the LORD and His strength; seek His face evermore!”* (1 Chronicles 16:11). *“Now, this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us”* (1 John 5:14).
2. **PRAY** that families live in peace and harmony. *“Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus”* (Philippians 4:6-7).
3. **PRAY** that we can *“Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you”* (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18). *“Let my prayer be set before You as incense, the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice”* (Psalm 141:2).

Wednesday

Fathers Teach &amp; Discipline

June 17

**PRAISE:**

*"I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving"* (Psalm 69:30). Thank your Lord, for Your works, Your name, Your ways, and Your word.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that fathers model humility before their families so as to teach them how to honor others throughout their lives. *"Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others"* (Philippians 2:3-4).
2. **PRAY** that fathers give wise instructions and *"speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine"* (Titus 2:1). For *"Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge"* (Proverbs 12:1a) and *"The wise in heart will receive commands"* (Proverbs 10:8).
3. **PRAY** that fathers use the Word with wisdom in disciplining their children. *"Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart"* (Proverbs 29:17). For *"the law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul"* (Psalm 19:7a).

Thursday

Generational Blessings

June 18

**PRAISE:**

*"For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed,"* says the LORD, who has mercy on you" (Isa. 54:10). Thank you for Your covenant with Israel and for Your peace over Israel.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that families walk in covenant from generation to generation. *"The LORD our God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments"* (Deuteronomy 7:9). For His *"mercy is for those who fear God from generation to generation"* (Luke 1:50).
2. **PRAY** that parents give testimony to the children/youth of God's strength and wonderful works. *"One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts"* (Psalm 145:4). *"That the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, that they may arise and declare them to their children, that they may set their hope in God"* (Psalm 78:6-7).

3. **PRAY** that parents understand the importance of the legacy they leave their children. Let us understand how God views the generations and the power of a godly life before our children (Exodus 20:1- 6).

**Friday**

**Godly Education**

**June 19**

**PRAISE:**

*“For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness. For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. O Lord of hosts, blessed is the man who trusts in You!” (Psalm 84:10-12).*

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that parents take the responsibility of educating our children in the precepts of God’s Word as a foundation for education. *“And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up” (Deuteronomy 6:6-7).*
2. Because knowledge belongs to the Lord, we **PRAY** that all educational institutions in (state) will allow the good news of the gospel, creating peaceful and righteous environments for our children. **PRAY** for a return to the fear of the Lord in our education system so that our children may have wisdom and knowledge. *“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge” (Proverbs 1:7).*
3. **PRAY** parents stand strong and protect their children by strongly protesting against schools using ungodly curriculum, providing obscene books, adopting demonically-inspired sexual preference and transgender policies, and promoting an anti-God worldview. We **PRAY** that schools for all ages teach *“...whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and there is anything praiseworthy - meditate on these things” (Philippians 4:8).*

**Saturday**

**Day of Thanksgiving**

**June 20**

*“This I recall to my mind; therefore I have hope. Through the Lord’s mercies we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness” (Lamentations 3:21-23).*

Sunday

Encouragement

June 21

*“But He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me” (2 Corinthians 12:9).*

WEEK 4: June 22 - 30

Monday

Repentance

June 22

**PRAISE:**

*“Let them praise Your great and awesome name” (Psalm 99:3). Holy are You, Lord Jesus, your name is above every other name.*

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. I repent for not trusting in You wholeheartedly and instead trusting in myself, my own understanding, knowledge, and talent, my own power, platform, and wealth, political figures, ungodly alliances, and the strength of my nation’s army. I have put my trust in people, as in the days of the Judges, and I have done what is right in my own eyes (Judges 21:25). Forgive me.
2. Forgive me for not walking in the fruit of the Spirit remembering your mercy on me. *“The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit” (Galatians 5:22-25).*
3. I repent for the times I have dishonored You by the words that I speak. Help me to *“put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of my mouth. Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him” (Colossians 3:8-9).*

Tuesday

Foundation in Love

June 23

**PRAISE:**

I praise you Father, that You keep my foot securely on Your path. *“My foot has held fast to His path; I have kept His way and not turned aside. “I have not departed from the command of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food” (Job 23:10-12).*

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that we embrace God's LOVE and make it the foundation for our lives. *"Neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the LOVE of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:39). "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in LOVE, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height to know the LOVE of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God" (Ephesians 3:14-19).*
2. **PRAY** that families exhibit the LOVE of God to one another. *"LOVE is patient and kind; LOVE does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. LOVE bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things" (1 Corinthians 13:4-8). Let all that you do be done with love" (1 Corinthians 16:14).*
3. **PRAY** that our families share the story of the LOVE of God with others. *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).*

**Wednesday****Blessings and Humility****June 24****PRAISE:**

*"I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness, and will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High" (Psalm 7:17). Praise Him for His righteousness is what saves us.*

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that parents bless their children and speak God's Word over them. Jesus Himself, *"took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them" (Mark 10:16).*
2. **PRAY** *"Likewise, you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble" (Luke 14:11). "By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches and honor and life" (Proverbs 22: 4).*
3. **PRAY** that children and youth's hearts are open to the instruction of their fathers. *"Hear, my son, your father's instruction" (Prov. 1:8a), "hear instruction and be wise" (Prov. 8:33) "...that you may be wise in your latter days" (Proverbs 19:20b).*

For “*A wise son makes a glad father*” (Prov. 15:20a). For when they heed the way of wisdom, the right paths are shown to the children so that their “... *steps will not be hindered, and when they run, they will not stumble*” (Prov. 4: 11-12).

Thursday

Fear of the Lord

June 25

**PRAISE:**

*“For You will light my lamp; the Lord my God will enlighten my darkness. As for God, His way is perfect; the Word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him”* (Psalm 18: 28 & 30). I praise You for Your Word that is tested and tried, that shows me how to walk in Your ways. Your Word keeps my heart and soul in righteousness and peace. I praise You for Your ways, that You set before me, for I am perfected in them.

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that parents teach and model the fear of the Lord before their children. For as it is written, *“In the fear of the Lord there is strong confidence, and his children will have refuge”* (Proverbs 14:26).
2. **PRAY** for peace, rest and protection to come to families who fear the Lord. For as it is written, *“The fear of the Lord leads to life, so that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by evil”* (Proverbs 19:23).
3. **PRAY** for the fear of the Lord to grip parents in such a way that they see the eternal before the temporal. **PRAY** that parents would prioritize church or other godly activities over sports, dance or any other activity that takes away from focusing the children on the eternal hope in Christ.

Friday

Children Be Not Deceived

June 26

**PRAISE:**

*“The Lord is your protector; the Lord is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore”* (Psalm 121:5-8).

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that our children seek truth and are not deceived by the enemy’s schemes. For *“the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding”* (Proverbs 9:10). **PRAY** that once our children see truth, they walk in it.

2. **PRAY** for those who speak confusion over our children, to come out of darkness into the light. **ASK** the Lord to encounter them with His presence. According to Isaiah 42:22, these people are *“robbed and spoiled; they are snared in holes and in prison houses. They are prey and no one delivers”*, but I cry out for them to be restored. Bring the blind by a way they do not know and lead them in paths of righteousness. Make darkness light before them!
3. **PRAY** for all confusion around sex, which the enemy calls “gender”, to be removed from the minds of our children. **PRAY** that blind eyes are opened and the veil is removed, to see male and female as God created them (2 Kings 6:17). God, You created male and female (Genesis 2). You, Father, have declared the intention for our children. *“All your sons will be taught of the Lord; and the well-being of your sons will be great”* (Isaiah 54:13).

**Day of Thanksgiving**

**June 27**

*“I will give You thanks with all my heart; I will sing praises to You before the gods”* (Psalm 138:1). We will praise YOU, Yahweh, before all the false gods worshiped in our land.

*“The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower”* (Psalm 18:2).

**WEEK 5: June 29 - 30**

**Monday**

**Prayer Over Israel**

**June 29**

**PRAISE:**

I exalt You, wise King. Praise You for Your faithfulness to Israel. *“The LORD your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be His people, His treasured possession”* (Deut.7:6).

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** *“for the peace of Jerusalem”* (Psalm 122:6). **PRAY** for protection over Israel, for Yahweh loves His people and the land He has chosen. As it is written, *“The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying: Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore, with lovingkindness I have drawn you”* (Jeremiah 31:3).

2. **PRAY** that the Jewish people acknowledge their covenant with Yahweh (Gen. 12:1-7) and that Israel comes to know their Messiah, Yeshua (Matthew 23:39; Romans 11:26). **PRAY** the offspring of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob return to Him, the God of their fathers, and walk in the Fear of Lord. *“How blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in His ways”* (Psalm 128:1).
3. **PRAY** that America stands resolute with Israel, God’s covenant people. **PRAY** that our governmental officials be the men and women who will stand in the gap for Israel! (Ezekiel 22:30). We will bless Israel in word and deed so that all the families of the earth shall be blessed (Gen 12:3).

**Tuesday**

**Prayer Over America**

**June 30**

**PRAISE:**

*“O God of our salvation, You who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of the far-off seas; who established the mountains by His strength, being clothed with power; You who still the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the peoples”* (Psalm 65:5b-7). Praise Him for He is our confidence!

**PRAYER POINTS:**

1. **PRAY** that our nation returns to the God of our Founding Father’s and stands strong with the joint resolution passed on July 30, 1956, by the 84th Congress, declaring IN GOD WE TRUST (Psalm 91:2). **CONTEND** that God’s intent for America was to birth this nation in peace, to reach people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. **PRAY** that God’s intent will be restored to America through the Church walking in His ways (Psalm 119:1-7).
2. **PRAY** that righteous leaders are chosen for local, state and federal governmental positions in our nation. As it is written, *“When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice”* (Proverbs 29:2). *“Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter, the one that remains faithful”* (Isaiah 26:2).
3. **PRAY** that our leaders will look to God for the salvation of our nation! **PRAY** that the Federal and State Supreme Courts will acknowledge God as the ultimate judge who measures out and dispenses justice. *“For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; He will save us”* (Isaiah 33:22).
4. **PRAY** for revival in America! **PRAY** that the HOPE within us will be seen by those who are hopeless and that they will desire “to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to *obtain* an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and unfading” (1 Peter 1:3-4).
